



EXPRESS ADVENTURE IN TORRES DEL PAINE

2 DAYS / 1 NIGHT

Our Express Adventure program will take you to visit the most iconic and representative places in Torres del Paine National Park in a dynamic way, allowing you to fully appreciate its beauty.

DAY 1 > Entrance to the Torres del Paine National Park, Torres Base Trekking.

Accommodation at our campsite.

DAY 2 > Trekking Viewpoints.

Return to Puerto Natales.

DAY 1

06:15 a 06:45 Hrs. / Pick Up

We depart from Puerto Natales heading to Torres del Paine National Park via Route 9.

After 1.5 hours of travel, we will arrive at the Laguna Amarga entrance, where we will proceed to register at the CONAF facilities. Then, we will head to the Welcome Center of the Las Torres Reserve, where our guides will give a pre-trek briefing as we prepare for the Base Torres trek. This trek is the most famous in the park and one of the most recognized in the world.

Along the way, we will be accompanied by our guides on a round-trip hike of approximately 22 km, lasting about 8 hours, along a trail of medium-high difficulty that will gradually immerse us in the mountain environment. Once we reach the Base Torres viewpoint, at 870 meters above sea level, we can enjoy our box lunch while taking in the spectacular view of the South, Central, and North Towers (De Agostini, Central, and Monzino), along with the Torres lagoon and glacier.

We will descend along the same trail back to the Welcome Center, where our vehicle will be waiting to take us to Camping Pehoé, located in the heart of the National Park next to the lake of the same

name, famous for its turquoise waters and offering a privileged view of the Paine Massif. Here, we will stay at our campsite, which features pre-assembled and equipped tents, as well as our dome, which we will use as a operations center to plan our outings and enjoy snacks and drinks together.

We offer full board meals; in the evening, we will have dinner at the Camping Pehoé restaurant, and the following day, after a refreshing rest, we will have breakfast at the restaurant and receive our box lunch for lunch before starting our activities for the second day.

DAY 2

08:00 Hrs.

We will undertake the Miradores Trek, an activity where we will explore the main viewpoints of the park.

We will begin with the ascent to the Cóndor viewpoint, located near our campsite, which will take approximately 2 hours round trip. Here, we will enjoy the park's most famous view, featuring Lake Pehoé with the Paine Massif as a backdrop. We will also appreciate the characteristic flora of the area, observe local birdlife with the majestic Andean Condor (Vultur gryphus) as the highlight, and take photographs.



Itinerary

On our return, we will board our vehicle and head to the Cuernos viewpoint to undertake a 2-hour round trip trek, where we will walk to the shores of Lake Nordenskjöld to enjoy a wonderful view of the Paine Massif.

After enjoying our box lunch, we will head to the Laguna Amarga Entrance to embark on our final trek along the Aonikenk Trail. This well-known biological corridor for local wildlife also traces the route of the area's early human inhabitants, who left their mark in a series of rock paintings that we will be able to see. This trek will offer opportunities to observe abundant birdlife and provide a very attractive view of the Paine Massif with the Paine River at its base. We will end this hike at the Sarmiento Entrance, where we will begin our return to Puerto Natales

Return to the city: 08:30 PM. approximately.
