



TREKKING SIERRA BAGUALES EXCURSION / FULL DAY

Sierra Baguales is a natural treasure, distant from the major tourist attractions of Chilean Patagonia.

Come with us to explore its remote landscapes, discover the charm of the unknown, and appreciate the wild nature of a place that was once a sea floor over 50 million years ago and holds significant geological and paleontological resources.









ITINERARY

07:00 a 07:30 Hrs. / Pick Up

Departure from Puerto Natales towards Sierra Baguales via Route 9.


After traveling 80 km, we will take a detour towards Sierra Baguales, located about 60 km northeast of Torres del Paine National Park, to enter the Baguales River valley. We will arrive at Estancia Tres Erres, known for its work and dedication to the preservation of local wildlife, especially the baguales horses—wild descendants of domesticated horses that have become wild and roam freely in this remote region, showcasing a remarkable adaptability.

We will start with a short 30-minute walk to reach the Laguna Irene area, where we can observe and photograph birdlife. We will have an initial introduction to the history of the local indigenous peoples, their relationship with this territory, and the process of colonization in Chilean Patagonia. After this introduction, we will board our vehicle to head to the area where we will begin the Sierra Baguales Trek, approximately 12.5 km round trip.


We will gradually ascend a moderately intense trail, where we will be able to see the impressive Sierra Baguales with its jagged ridges and unique reddish mountains, home to various local wildlife species such as pumas (*Puma concolor*), guanacos (*Lama guanicoe*), and condors











(*Vultur gryphus*). If we are lucky, we may even spot a herd of wild horses.

During this hike, we will cross the Río Baguales and be able to observe and identify marine fossils in the surrounding area that reveal a history of over 50 million years. At this location, we will enjoy our box lunch and rest while admiring the immense and moving expanse of the Patagonian landscape.

We will begin the descent along the same trail to return to our vehicle, which will take us back to Puerto Natales W

Return to the city: 18:30 Hrs. approximately.
