A great opportunity for those who love nature and want to discover the spectacular landscapes of Patagonia, consisting of 5 days and 4 nights in Puerto Natales, with daily departures to Torres del Paine National Park. Our Patagonia Indómita programme will take you to see beautiful landscapes such as the Torres Base Viewpoint; you will sail the icy waters of Grey Lake, to be able to appreciate closely this imposing glacier mass belonging to the Southern Ice Field. You will visit Lake Pehoé, Paine Waterfall, among other attractions of the park, while in Puerto Natales we will visit historical towns such as Puerto Consuelo, Puerto Prat and Laguna Sofía, among others. We will travel along the Patagonian roads in our private transport. Our staff is prepared to make each excursion a unique experience.

4 NIGHTS IN HOTEL COSTANERA OR SIMILAR

You will have the privilege of staying in one of the hotels with the most beautiful infrastructure and view of the Última Esperanza Fjord and the waterfront of the city of Puerto Natales. Resting in Patagonia is synonymous with total relaxation, but above all with marvellous views from the comfort of your room.








DAY 1

TREKKING SIERRA BAGUALES

07:30 a 08:00 Hrs. / Pick Up

Departure from Puerto Natales to Sierra Baguales on Route 9.

Arrival at the Tres Erres ranch, renowned for its work and dedication to the preservation of the local fauna, especially the feral horses or baguales, where we will take a short walk of half an hour to reach the Laguna Irene sector, where we will be able to observe and photograph avifauna. We will have a first approach to the history of the local native people and the process of colonization of the Chilean Patagonia. After this introduction, we will begin the trekking of 12 Kms. and 6 Hrs. approximately, in which we will ascend by a path observing the imposing Sierra Baguales, where diverse species of local fauna coexist.

During this hike we will be able to observe and identify marine fossils.

We will start the descent along the same path to return to our vehicle, which will take us back to Puerto Natales W

Return to the city: 18:30 Hrs. approximately.























DAY 2

TREKKING MIRADORES

06:30 a 07:00 Hrs. / Pick Up

Departure from Puerto Natales on Route 9 towards Torres del Paine National Park.

After checking in at the CONAF offices in Portería Laguna Amarga, we will start the 2 hour trekking to Portería Sarmiento along the Aonikenk trail, a recognized biological corridor of the local fauna and also a corridor of the first human inhabitants of the sector, who left their mark in a series of cave paintings, which we will be able to appreciate. This route will give us the opportunity to observe abundant birdlife and a very attractive view of the Paine Massif with the Paine River at its feet.

From the Laguna Amarga portería we will go to the Salto Grande sector, to appreciate the power of the waterfall of the same name, which drains the Nordenskjöld Lake and feeds the Pehoé Lake. Here we start a 2 hour round trip trekking to the Mirador Cuernos, at the foot of the Nordenskjöld Lake, where we will enjoy a spectacular view of the Paine Massif. Here our guide will characterize the landscape from a geological point of view.

We will have lunch at our campsite in the Pehoé Sector and after resting with the view of the Cuernos del Paine, we will head to the Condor Viewpoint, where we will be able to observe condor birds and enjoy the privilege of being in front of the most iconic view of the Paine Massif and Lake Pehoé W

Arriving at our transport, we will get ready to return to Puerto Natales

Return to the city: 18:30 Hrs. approximately.

DAY 3

TREKKING BASE TORRES

06:30 a 07:00 Hrs. / Pick Up

Departure from Puerto Natales towards Torres del Paine National Park.

Once we enter the park, we will go to the Welcome Centre of the Las Torres Reserve, where our guides will do the previous induction while we get ready to start the Base Torres trekking.

This trekking is the most famous inside the park and also one of the most recognized in the world. During the journey we will be accompanied by our guides on a 22 Kms. round trip for approximately 8 Hrs. on a medium-high difficulty trail that will gradually introduce us to the mountain environment.

Once we arrive at the Torres Base Viewpoint, at 870 m.a.s.l., we can have our box lunch while we enjoy a spectacular view of the South, Central and North towers (De Agostini, Central and Monzino), next to the Torres lagoon and glacier. We will make the descent by the same path W

Return to the city: 21:30 Hrs. approximately.



















DAY 4

LAGO GREY NAVIGATION

1st NAVIGATION: 06:00 to 06:30 AM. / 2nd NAVIGATION: 09:00 to 09:30 AM. / 3rd NAVIGATION: 12:00 to 12:30 PM.

Departure from Puerto Natales towards Torres del Paine National Park along the Y-290 Route.

Once we enter through Portería Serrano, we will head towards the Grey sector through beautiful landscapes.

On this tour you will embark on a navigation not to be missed on your visit to Torres del Paine National Park. The Grey III catamaran will take you on a navigation across the lake of approximately 2,5 hours.

You will enjoy a vigorous landscape full of floating icebergs, exuberant vegetation and an imposing view of the Grey Glacier, part of the Southern Patagonian Ice Field and the West face of the Paine Massif while receiving attention on board w

The return to Puerto Natales will depend on the departure time of the catamaran.

















DAY 5

HISTORICAL TOUR PUERTO NATALES / HALF DAY

Departure from Puerto Natales towards the most iconic and representative places of our beautiful city.

In this tour of approximately 3 hours, we will make stops at the most important points such as Villa Cariño, Colonia Isabel Riquelme and Costanera de Puerto Natales. After these milestones, we will start a tour through the historical roads outside the city, where we will go to the towns of Puerto Bories, Puerto Prat and Puerto Consuelo, which are the first modern human settlements as a result of the colonization process.

To finish our excursion, we will head towards Laguna Sofía, where we will observe its particular flora and fauna, condoreras and fascinating views of the Sierra Señoret and the Cordillera Prat W
