



FULL DAY TORRES DEL PAINE

EXCURSION / FULL DAY

The Full Day Torres del Paine is a panoramic tour through the internal roads of Torres del Paine National Park aboard our vehicle, with stops at its main viewpoints, where you can fully appreciate the impressive beauty of a unique natural environment.

A must for nature and photography lovers.



















07:00 to 07:45 AM. / Pick Up

Departure from your accommodation in Puerto Natales via Route 9, heading towards Torres del Paine National Park.

Our first stop will be in Villa Cerro Castillo, a historic border town with Argentina, rooted in livestock farming. Here, we'll visit the main souvenir shop, have a drink at the café, and use the restrooms.

We will continue to the Lago Sarmiento viewpoint, where we will learn about the unique features of this lake and enjoy the first panoramic view of the Paine Massif and part of the Patagonian Andes, as well as our first encounters with the characteristic wildlife of the area. We will then proceed to visit the Laguna Amarga viewpoint, located at the foot of the lagoon of the same name, offering an excellent view of the Torres del Paine. Afterward, we will take a detour before entering the park to visit Paine Waterfall, our first encounter with the Paine River, the main watercourse of the area, which reveals the mountainous terrain's slope through a series of rapids and waterfalls.

We will enter Torres del Paine National Park through the Laguna Amarga Gate, where after registering, we will begin our Full Day tour along the main interior routes from East to West

As we ascend, we will observe fascinating geological formations that reveal the glaciological activity that shaped the park's landscape.



















We will also see lagoons on both sides of the route, rich with birdlife, until we reach the Nordenskjöld Lake Viewpoint. Here, we can admire the features of a glacial lake, with a unique perspective of the Paine Massif in the background, while our guide provides a geological interpretation of the landscape.

We will continue towards the Salto Grande Viewpoint, where we will take a 15-minute, low-intensity walk to visit the spectacular waterfall with a 12-meter drop, which serves as the drainage from Lake Nordenskjöld to Lake Pehoé. As we ascend a small hill, one of the most magnificent views of the Cuernos del Paine will unfold before

We will proceed to the Pehoé Campground area to visit the shores of Lake Pehoé, renowned for its turquoise waters and a privileged viewpoint where you can observe birdlife and capture excellent photographs. Here, you can have lunch or enjoy a packed lunch.

We will take our vehicle to the banks of the Paine River once again. We will pass through the Puente Weber and Administration sectors, located at the former main house of the Río Paine ranch—an important part of the area's livestock development during the colonization period and the origin of the current park—on our way to the Lago Grey sector. Here, we will do a moderately intense 1-hour round-trip trek through an ancient Lenga (Nothofagus pumilio) forest to the shore of Lago Grey, with its gray waters and floating icebergs.

















From there, we will be able to admire the distant Grey Glacier and a spectacular view of Paine Grande from its western face, along with the snow-capped peaks of the Olguín Range.

We will return along the same route to exit the park through the Serrano Guard Station, where we will begin our journey back to Puerto Natales via Route Y-290. Along the way, we will visit the Grey Viewpoint, which offers a distant view of the glacier, the Serrano River basin, and Lake Toro.

Our final stop will be the Milodon Cave Natural Monument, a group of glacial caves that is an important archaeological and paleontological site, impressive for its dimensions and historical significance W
